

PRAYER STUDY 16

"Weapons of our Warfare-PART 3"

2nd Corinthians 10:4-5

"For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal[of human devising], but mighty through God to the pulling down[demolishing] of strongholds[fortresses], casting down imaginations[vain reasoning and analyzing] and every high thing[high mental thought or thing] that exalteth itself against the knowledge[THE WORD] of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ."

THE WORD

"We believe God's Word and know it is TRUE. Jeremiah 1:12 says God watches over His Word to perform it, and Isaiah 55:11 says His Word will not return to Him void, but will accomplish what it is sent to do. Knowing this, we can pray the Word about a situation and expect God-kind of results. The person we pray for has a free choice whether to accept what God has for them and, by praying The Word on their behalf, we give them the benefit of choosing either life or death, blessing or cursing, going God's Way or their own way(Deuteronomy 30:19). As we confess His Word, believe it, read it, speak it and act on it we begin to merge with it and it becomes our way of life. As we live the Word, His strength, His ability, His peace, His love, His joy, His confidence and His faith become ours. As we pray His Word, the weary ones, the weak ones, the deceived ones, the sick ones will be ministered to, protected by and brought gently to our Good Shepherd. "

SPECIAL WORD SCRIPTURES

1. Psalm 119 is the longest chapter in the Bible with 176 verses (all but just a couple refer to the Word of God). Verse 9 tells us that the Word cleanses us(This is typed by the brazen laver filled with water with which the priest washed himself in the Old Testament Tabernacle). Verse 24 tells us that the Word is our counselor. Verse 105 tells us that the Word is our guide. Verse 165 tells us that the Word gives us peace.
2. Psalm 107:20- "He sent His Word and healed them and delivered them from all their destructions." (Matt 8:8)
3. Parable of the sower: Mark 4, Luke 8-*Now the parable is this: The seed is the word of God. Those by the wayside are they that hear; then cometh the devil, and taketh away the word out of their hearts, lest they should believe and be saved. They on the rock are they who, when they hear, receive the word with joy, and these have no root, who for a while believe, and in time of testing fall away. And that which fell among thorns are they who, when they have heard, go forth and are choked with cares and riches and pleasures of this life, and bring no fruit to perfection. But that on the good ground are they who, in an honest and good heart, having heard the word, keep it, and bring forth fruit with patience.*
4. John 1:1-In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.
5. Ephesians 6:17-...*the Sword of the Spirit, which is the Word of God.*

- In Proverbs and Ecclesiastes he is our Wisdom.
- In the Song of Solomon He is the Lover and the Bridegroom.
- In Isaiah He is the Prince of Peace.
- In Jeremiah He is the Righteous Branch.
- In Lamentations He is the Weeping Prophet.
- In Ezekiel He is the Wonderful Four-Faced Man.
- In Daniel He is the Fourth Man in the burning fiery furnace.
- In Hosea He is the Faithful Husband, forever married to the backslider.
- In Joel He is the Baptizer with the Holy Ghost and Fire.
- In Amos He is our Burden-bearer.
- In Obadiah He is the Mighty to Save.
- In Jonah He is our Great Foreign Missionary.
- In Micah He is the Messenger of Beautiful Feet carrying the Gospel.
- In Nahum He is the Avenger of God's Elect.
- In Habakkuk He is God's Evangelist, crying, "Revive thy work in the midst of the years."
- In Zephaniah He is the Savior.
- In Haggai He is the Restorer of God's Lost Heritage.
- In Zechariah He is the Fountain Opened in the House of David for sin and uncleanness.
- In Malachi He is the Sun of Righteousness, rising with healing in His wings.
- In Matthew He is the Messiah.
- In Mark He is the Wonder-worker.
- In Luke He is the Son of Man.
- In John He is the Son of God.
- In Acts He is the Holy Spirit.
- In Romans He is the Justifier.
- In Corinthians He is the Gifts of the Holy Spirit.
- In Galatians He is the Redeemer from the Curse of the Law.
- In Ephesians He is the Christ of Unsearchable Riches.
- In Philippians He is the God Who Supplies All Our Needs.
- In Colossians He is the Fullness of the Godhead Bodily.
- In 1st and 2nd Thessalonians He is our Soon-coming King.
- In 1st and 2nd Timothy He is our Mediator between God and Man.
- In Titus He is our Faithful Pastor.
- In Philemon He is a Friend that Sticketh Closer than a Brother.
- In Hebrews He is the Blood of the Everlasting Covenant.
- In James He is the Great Physician.
- In 1st and 2nd Peter He is the Chief Shepherd who soon shall appear with a crown of unfading Glory.
- In 1st, 2nd, and 3rd John He is Everlasting Love.
- In Jude He is the Lord coming with Ten Thousands of His Saints.
- In Revelation He is the King of Kings and the Lord of Lords.

A most interesting scripture about the Word of God comes from the Lord Himself in Psalm 138:2b where He indicates that He values His Word even more than He values His own name, the name whereby we are saved and whereby demons flee! And indeed John 1 tells us that He, as the Word, became flesh and dwelled among us.

...for Thou hast magnified Thy word above all Thy name.

Psalm 138:2

Since God so loved the World that He gave His only Son Jesus, and I have believed in Him and made Him my Lord (John 3:16, Rom. 10:8-10); I am a new creature, old things have passed away, all things are new and I am the righteousness of God in Christ Jesus.
